## Play skills

- -Opportunities to develop play skills
- --[]To experience being around other people including adults and peers
- --[]Observing others play
- --[]Be supported to participate in play games.
- --[]To experience Sensio motor activities exploring objects around them e.g sensory play / single toy exploration
- --[]Initiate and make a choice of what to play with (initially from a smaller number of options)
- --[]Observe others playing / have play modelled to them
- --[]Play alongside others (but not necessarily with them)
- --[]To experience sensory play exploring different textures
- --[]To experience one to one games
- --[]To experience small group games
- --[]To experience relational play with two or more objects e.g. filling and emptying containers
- --[]To experience symbolic / pretend play alone or with others
- --[]To experience socio dramatic play either alone or with others
- --[]Explore playgrounds adventure play
- --[]To experience board games
- --[]To experience card games
- --[]To explore interactive games including switches, iPad, computers and remote control items.
- --[]To experience sports games e.g. football, rounder's.

## Interacting with others

- -Opportunities to interact with others
- --[]Initiate interaction with familiar people e.g. smiling, turning, giving eye contact
- --[]Show they can work co-actively with familiar people e.g. join in a 'row the boat' or allow their hands to be used for eating
- --[]Show anticipation of familiar social activities and events e.g. start to rock for 'row your boat' or lean forwards to be lifted up
- --[]Show they have had enough of a social interaction e.g. by turning away or looking down
- --[]Show preference for particular people, objects and activities persisting at interaction

- --[]Respond with interest in the actions of others close by e.g. make eye contact, turn towards, reaching out, vocalising
- --[]Engage actively in familiar social activities and events e.g. join in action songs or hold up arms for coat
- --[]Initiate or make simple meaningful gestures e.g. pointing or using simple signs, photographs
- --[]Use their voices to join in a 'conversation' e.g. babbling
- --[]Attempt simple words and phrases in imitation e.g. mumma, woof, all gone, bye bye,more
- --[]Use a few words appropriately e.g. more, names, yes, no, mumma whatever is appropriate for that child

## Self-expression and creativity

- -Opportunities for creativity and self expression
- --[]To express themselves through music art and drama
- --[]To develop opinions and likes dislikes about music art and drama.
- --[]To listen and respond to different types of music
- --[]To explore different types of music instruments
- --[]To experience / participate in a range of musical activities
- --[]To observe art being created
- --[]To explore different colours
- --[]To explore and respond to a range of art materials.
- --[]To experience making different types of art including painting, drawing, model making, clay and sensory experiences.
- --[]To observe drama productions
- --[]To participate in drama and role play productions
